



## Burglar caught using GPS monitoring pleads guilty to five break-ins

A Stoddard man suspected in a string of La Crosse area break-ins faces up to 38 years behind bars after being convicted Monday of five burglaries.

Joshua Dull, 24, pleaded guilty to the five burglaries committed between October 2010 and January 2011. Two other burglaries, one attempted burglary and charges of drug possession and bail jumping were dismissed as part of a plea agreement.

Police used GPS monitoring data to connect Dull, who was free on bond pending burglary charges, to one of the burglarized homes. They later found evidence in his home from other break-ins.

Prosecutors under the agreement will seek prison at the Aug. 19 sentencing but will not request a specific term. Each of the burglary charges carries a maximum of 7.5 years.
